  - Repainted stop lines at intersections
  - Whaley Asphalt resealed areas
  - o PNG right-of-way project
  - Ice maker repaired at clubhouse
  - Cable installed at clubhouse
  - Clubhouse interior painted
  - o Big screen TV to be installed before year end
  - Monument lighting for signs
  - o LED lights in 3 of 4 corners of pool
  - Erosion behind monument on Dillard being corrected with rocks
  - o Easter egg hunt
  - Halloween party
  - o Book club started
  - Abandoned lots/homes monitored

- Future Projects presented by Ted Higginbotham:
  - Sound system for clubhouse
  - Sidewalk to pool
  - Patio Project need extension at back of clubhouse to accommodate clubhouse trash cans, extension for kiddie area at pool
  - Outdoor bathroom at back of clubhouse for access by tennis court/volleyball area with access by card system
  - o Paint fence line that runs down Runnion land
  - o Extend fence between Townes and Estates area was left bare since fire
  - Sidewalk around ponds
  - o Landscaping left bare from PNG removal of trees, etc. to be planted
  - o Furniture for clubhouse, rugs, pictures, new tables committee to be formed
  - o Pool tables and umbrellas needed, mushroom needs to be repaired
  - o Up lighting on entrances and for trees around neighborhood
  - o Pool resurfacing required cost approximately \$25,000 to \$30,000
  - o Annual BBQ pool party to be continued via caterer
